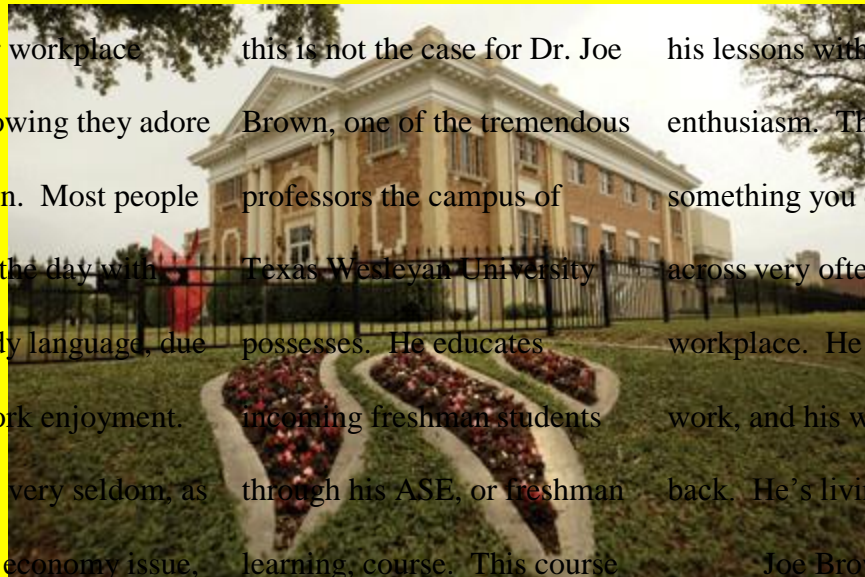




Professor Lives Dream

When asking Dr. Brown about his family, he had some interesting facts to share with me. For example, his mother was married six times and his dad, four. He claimed both of

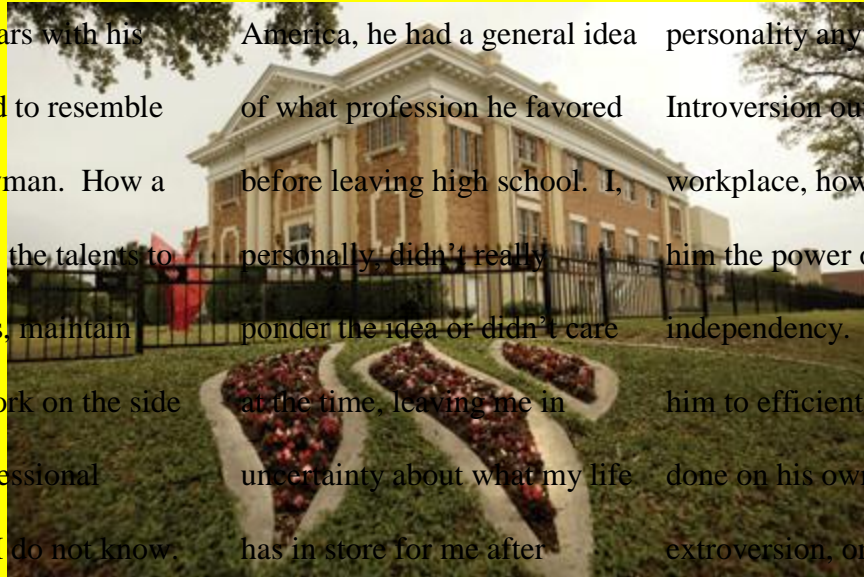
Dr. Brown attended the University of Arkansas, where he received his Bachelors of Arts degree in speech and drama. He would later attend Southern Methodist
